**INSTRUCTION SHEET -- SCOTTISH RITE MASONS' N.T. SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**  
***(INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED!)***

This award shall be made to a student who has completed at least 15 credit hours from an accredited academic, vocational, or technical institution, or cannot have graduated from high school or a GED program within the last 5 years if a first-time student, or entering a graduate level at an accredited institution and approved by the Knoxville Scottish Rite Scholarship Committee (or Committee). The applicant must be a bonafide resident of our designated 24-county East Tennessee area and meet eligibility requirements as outlined below.

Applicants shall provide an official copy of his/her college transcripts or official documentation of graduation date of high school or GED program and complete name, phone number, and physical address of each reference. Applicants shall inform the Knoxville Scottish Rite Scholarship Committee of any other scholarships for which application has been made.

Applicants shall supply a current, completed copy of their Student Aid Report as returned to them from the Department of Education that contains his/her Expected Family Contribution. Applicants may secure the Free Application for Federal Student Aid from their college financial aid office, from his/her high school after January 1, or at - [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).

The deadline for receipt of the completed application is June 7.

The selection of the recipient and administration of this scholarship shall be vested in a Committee designated by the Knoxville Scottish Rite's Executive Board. The Knoxville Scottish Rite Scholarship Committee shall make the award no later than August 10<sup>th</sup> of each year and shall consider the following:

After the student has been chosen and the Knoxville Scottish Rite Scholarship Committee notified of a college or university selected, the Secretary shall notify the college on or before August 10<sup>th</sup>, the Secretary shall remit the \$500.00 to the college or university selected with instructions that it is to be credited to the student in equal quarterly (or semester) payments during the school year. Second and subsequent installments to the student are dependent upon an acceptable student record. Should the award winner either fail to enroll, fail to maintain a satisfactory student record, or withdraw from school - the balance left in the fund shall be returned to the Knoxville Scottish Rite Bodies. Because of unforeseeable future events or decisions made by the recipient that are not mentioned in this document that would deem the recipient ineligible or not remain qualified by the Knoxville Scottish Rite Scholarship Committee after the scholarship is awarded, the Knoxville Scottish Rite Bodies reserve the right to revoke this award for proper cause. Proper cause shall be determined by the Knoxville Scottish Rite Scholarship Committee.

All scholarship recipients will have his/her name, college, major of study, and picture (if provided) featured in the Knoxville Scottish Rite newsletter and/or the Knoxville Scottish Rite social media sites.

Funds may be deferred upon request by the recipient and approval by the Committee if such a request is due to participation in a continuing education program (internship or co-op program). In no case shall any portion of the award be valid beyond one calendar year from the initial granting of the award. If for any other reason the student fails to begin or continue enrollment, all or the remainder of the funds shall be forfeited by the recipient.

- Bona-fide resident of Knoxville Scottish Rite 24-county area (e.g. "permanent residence" as determined by the Knoxville Scottish Rite Scholarship Committee)
